Shade in sitting area	A visit to the courts during different times of the day is needed to determine how to create more shade. The angle of the sun makes it difficult to keep the sitting area shaded. Sheila brought up the idea of getting fans to be installed in the sitting area. The softball club has them in the dugouts and they have helped a great deal. Emergency Plans	When winds are above a proscribed strength, we will be notified that windscreens need to be dropped, and furniture secured. We are formulating a flow chart of who gets notified and what they are to do. Sean Casey will be the person to contact us. League managers will call members of their leagues.
